Australian Legislative Regime

The central paradigm for our environmental legal system is ecologically sustainable development.

The environmental legal system in Australia is structured in four levels:

- International law;
- Commonwealth (Federal or Australian) law;
- State/Territory law; and
- Common Law.



Legal Obligations in Australia

Broadly, our environmental legal system requires all people conducting activities that affect the environment to do three things:

- obtain and comply with any necessary licence or government approval;
- comply with any relevant standard imposed by the law, including taking all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent or minimise environmental harm; and
- if unlawful, material or serious environmental harm occurs or may occur, notify the relevant regulator.

International Legislative Regime

Varies depending on the jurisdiction but developing countries that have established environmental laws generally have many similarities to Australian law including:

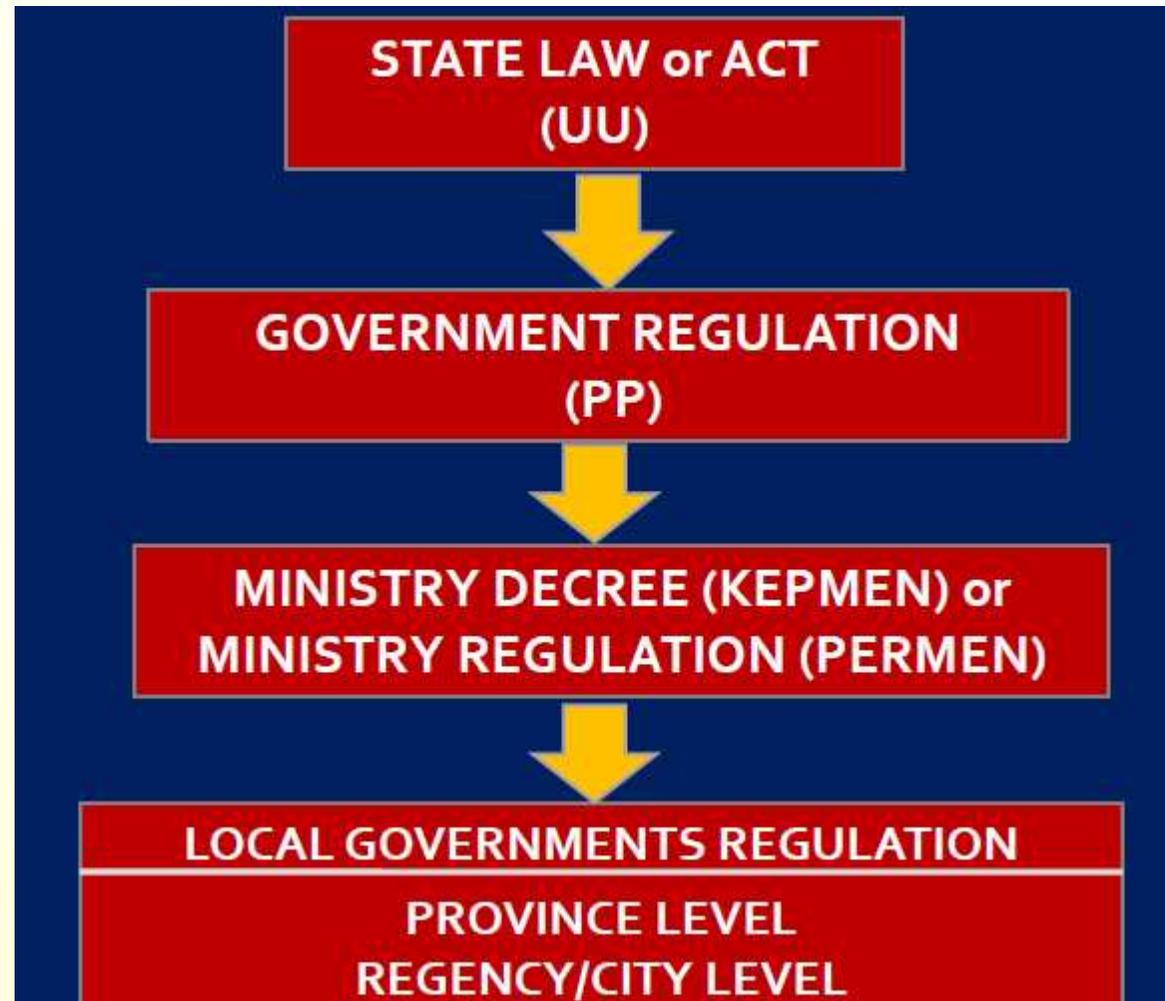
- Based on principle of sustainable development.
- Similar definition of environment;
- Require some form of EIA;
- Preparation of an EMP; and
- Penalties for corporations and personal liability provisions for company directors and officers.

Indonesian Legislative Regimes

INDONESIA

- First Environmental Law in 1982; updated in 1987 and again in 2009.
- Many environmental regulations; including laws, regulations, decrees etc. issued by different Ministries.
- National, provincial and regency/city government agencies all administer environmental regulations with extensive reporting requirements in each case.
- One site had 24 environmental compliance documents and over 400 in total.

Hierarchy of Indonesian Regulations



LAOS PDR

- Environmental Protection Law 1999 updated in 2012.
- Water Law Forestry Law, Land Law.
- Mining, Exploration and Production Agreement.
- EIA for major projects.
- IEE for minor projects.
- Environmental Management and Monitoring Plan (requires updating every three years).

Compliance v's Enforcement

COMPLIANCE

- *'the state of conformity with obligations, imposed by a State, its competent authorities and agencies on the regulated community, whether directly or through conditions and requirements in permits, licences and authorizations.'*

ENFORCEMENT

- *'the range of procedures and actions employed by a State, its competent authorities and agencies to ensure that organizations or persons, potentially failing to comply with environmental laws or regulations, can be brought or returned into compliance and/or punished through civil, administrative or criminal action.'*

- ISO 14001 – Environmental management Systems Standard
- International Cyanide Management Code
- ICMM - 10 Sustainable Development Principles
- GRI – Global Reporting Initiative
- E3 Plus – Framework for Responsible Exploration



Managing compliance

- Experienced and competent personnel
- Stakeholder engagement program
- Adequate resourcing
- Robust management systems
- Risk management processes
- Compliance/ Obligations register
- Monitoring programs and data management systems
- Corrective action systems
- Inspections and audit programs
- Robust information and records management processes

Conclusion
